

**RESOLUTION 2013- 093**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ESTABLISHED FEES FOR THE GALLATIN COUNTY COURT SERVICES PROGRAM**

This Resolution was introduced by Steve Ette, Gallatin County Court Services Director; moved by Commissioner MARTINEAU and seconded by Commissioner WHITE. The Resolution was adopted UNANIMOUSLY.

WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners previously established fees for the Gallatin County Court Services Program in its Resolution 2011-067 and the fees are in need of amendment;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-5-2101, MCA the Gallatin County Commissioners have the authority to manage the business and concerns of the county in all cases where no other provision is made by law;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-5-2133, MCA the County may charge a fee to recover the costs of providing electronic government services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §46-23-1005 Gallatin County has established a misdemeanor probation office as part of the Gallatin County Court Service Program;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-6-4013, MCA allows the County to charge fees that are reasonable and related to the cost of providing the service;

WHEREAS, fees for the Gallatin County Court Services Program were determined to be are reasonable and related to the cost of providing the service in Resolution 2011-067;

WHEREAS, additional fees and changes in fees set forth in this Resolution are justified as reasonable and related to the cost of providing service as follows: 1)The processing fee for Out of State referrals provides for the additional costs and staff time to coordinate with referring agency; 2) the increase in the Money Management Program fee covers the cost of the materials associated with the program; 3)any increase of program fees to offset increasing cost of materials; 4) any increase in processing fees is to offset staff time and materials associated with deployment of monitoring equipment; 5) the onetime fees for equipment offsets the costs to Gallatin County associated with lost and damaged equipment; and 6) grant funding costs are to align fee structure to include the daily charges associated with the Montana Sheriff, Peace Officers Association grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

All of the fees set forth in Gallatin County Resolution 2011-067 are replaced as follows for the Gallatin County Court Services Program:
