

RESOLUTION NO. BPC2009- 002

A RESOLUTION OF THE GALLATIN COUNTY BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS PROHIBITING DOGS INSIDE THE BOUNDARY OF THE DINOSAUR PLAYGROUND AT THE REGIONAL PARK

THIS RESOLUTION was introduced by the Board of Park Commissioners, moved by Commissioner Deb Kane, and seconded by Commissioner Rick Fink. This resolution was adopted unanimously.

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2004, the Gallatin County Commissioners, pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. 7-16-2301 et.seq., created a Board of Park Commissioners (Resolution No. 2004-130); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners manages and oversees all county parkland within the Gallatin County; and

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. 7-16-2322(i) provides that the Board of Park Commissioners may make rules for the use of the land and facilities by the public; and

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. 7-16-2322(ii) provides that the Board of Park Commissioners may provide penalties for the violations of park rules; and

WHEREAS, exposure of animals, on leash or off leash, inside a designated children's playground is a detriment to the use and enjoyment of park facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That it is a violation of this Resolution and hereby subject to civil penalties for any person in the Dinosaur Playground at the Gallatin County Regional Park located at 1707 Vaquero Parkway, Bozeman, MT, 59718 to bring an animal, on a leash or off, inside the fenced boundary of the playground.

Violation of may be subject to civil penalty(ies) of up to \$500.
