Mr. Gale discussed the Red Flag Law, and how this could affect Montana. This is a gun control law that permits temporary removal of firearms from a person who may be a danger to themselves or others. Mr. Peluso mentioned that NAMI has provided gun locks to those who may need them.

The Legislative Luncheon could potentially be a monthly posting, instead of every two years to maintain constant contact. Major needs and issues that affect our community need adequate focus by legislators. A needs assessment should be discussed during the December meeting, and have a list of prioritized items to discuss in depth.
