RE: Gallatin County Regulation of the Cultivation, Processing, or Selling of Marijuana or Marijuana Products

DATE: January 2, 2024

This memo shall serve as Gallatin County's notice to the Montana Department of Revenue, to the extent that a response is required under §16-12-207 MCA or other applicable statutes or administrative rules, concerning the County's regulation of the cultivation, processing, or selling of marijuana or marijuana products. As you know, marijuana licensing and regulation is addressed and approved by the Montana Department of Revenue, Cannabis Control Division.

At the present time, Gallatin County has not adopted any regulations, ordinances, or resolutions that specifically restrict the cultivation, processing, or selling of marijuana or marijuana products in unincorporated Gallatin County.

When such uses are proposed, they are reviewed on a site-specific basis for compliance with any applicable zoning rules in the exact same manner that any other land use is reviewed.

The Gallatin County Department of Planning and Community Development will no longer provide individual letters for applicants to submit to the Department of Revenue. Should they wish to do so, applicants can fill out our standard Property Information Request Form (see attached), specify the specific proposed use and location, and Department of Planning and Community Development Staff can indicate on that form whether any specific requirements or reviews are required for the proposed use of property.
